

RoHS declaration

Dear Sir or Madam,

the following declaration applies to all electronic hardware produced by the KATHREIN Sachsen GmbH and is based on the information provided by our suppliers as well as the certain knowledge according to our processes.

Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS) of the European Parliament and the Council of 8 June 2011 describes the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The list of hazardous substances was updated by putting in force its amended Directives 2015/863/EU („RoHS 3“) and 2017/2102/EU.

RoHS stands for the „**R**estriction **o**f (the use of certain) **H**azardous **S**ubstances in electrical and electronic Equipment. It is in force as of 3 January 2013. As a manufacturer of electronic products, KATHREIN Sachsen GmbH is aware of its obligations under RoHS. According to this and bades on our current state of knowledge, the restricted substances are not used in our products above the compulsory weight limit.

The following substances are included:

1. Lead (Pb)	≤ 0.1%
2. Mercury (Hg)	≤ 0.1%
3. Cadmium (Cd)	≤ 0.01%
4. Hexavalent chromium (Cr ⁶⁺)	≤ 0.1%
5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	≤ 0.1%
6. Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	≤ 0.1%
7. Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	≤ 0.1%
8. Butyl benzyl phthalate (BPP)	≤ 0.1%
9. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	≤ 0.1%
10. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	≤ 0.1%

This declaration is regularly reviewed and modified as necessary in the course of any amendments to the RoHS Directive and its annexes.
